East Brady residents can now pay their water/sewer bill on line! We now have a secure link on our web-site where you can use your credit/debit card to pay your water/sewer bill online. A 3% service fee is added for this convenience. Reminder.....Bills are **due the last day of the month**. They must be received in the office by that day. If you think the post office will not deliver it by the last day, use the bill drop box located at the Ferry St. corner of the Community Center. The next day a late fee is assessed. Save yourself a little money and pay your bill on time. If you have water line insurance added to your bill, and the bill is **NOT** paid on time, your line insurance is not in effect.

Water/Sewer News

The Consumer Confidence Report for 2020 is complete. Please go to our website at www.eastbradyborough.com There is a link on the left side where you will find the report. If you would like to have a printed copy, they are available in the office.

On the back of this newsletter you will see a "Tier 3 Notice". Last year, the DEP asked us to do Lead & Copper testing every 6 months as opposed to every year. We missed testing, so we had to issue this Notice. The water quality was not effected. Steps have been taken so that this doesn't happen again.

House Numbers

Ordinance 2014-1 regulates the numbering of houses and structures in our Borough. All structures must have a reflective sign on it with the proper 911 address. The sign should be placed on the front of your house and be clearly visible. The numbers should be a minimum of 3 inches in height. This is for the safety of all residents. If you are in need of police, EMS or Fire, these numbers will help them find you.

Burning Ordinance

Ordinance 2010-02 regulates burning. You can burn household trash in a burn container from 6 am to 6 pm Monday-Saturday. No Sunday burning and no holiday burning. The fire must be attended to at all times. Recreational fires are allowed if contained and attended to.
