**Water/Sewer-** The DEP disapproved of the comprehensive monitoring plan that was submitted – DEP would like a new monitoring plan to reflect the current number of operational modes by March 31, 2026 (copy of email from Alicia MacBeth provided). This was submitted on 3/31/26 by LSSE.

- Sanitary Well Cap Bid was advertised again in the next two editions of the Leader Vindicator (bid opening is on April 20<sup>th</sup>).
- Residents need to trim their shrubbery so maintenance personal can obtain readings easily.
- There was a water leak at 507 Purdum Street. Hiles Excavating fixed it.
- There was a leak at 172 Rexhide Dr – the owner had that fixed.
- Discuss Line Insurance (send out brochures / post cards to our residents). This information is provided, asked and explained by the Secretary when new residents put the water/sewer in their names.
