Streets & Street Lights: Mark Skarbec estimated the paving of E 1st Street at \$51,822. The council determined the price of oil is currently too high and it is best to wait until we have more than (1) road to pave to reduce cost.

- Macurack HVAC may be interested in contract work for the Borough; he will be included when we have projects.

Main Street Committee: Barb met with Sharon D’Andrea (CCEDC) to discuss the \$100k that is available to (2) business owners from each community to improve the façade of their buildings located on Main Street.

Building- The Gym floor was professionally cleaned last week – they stated that it was very well maintained and the following cleaning can be arranged for 2028.
